COVID 19 precautions

Masks and Sanitizing stations available throughout the property

Concession Available (Debit or Credit card only) (one-way entry and exit (no seating in lounges))

Bring your own chairs for viewing rings (Bleacher seating not available)

Masks required inside all buildings, including stabling area

LIMITED stabling (26 in indoor arena, 6 in hay shed, 10 in Quonset) NO tack stalls

Riders, Horse owners and Trainers only allowed in Stabling area (family members and friends not allowed in Stabling area)

Entry ONLY to area where your horse is stabled. Outdoor Horse Wash area.

Maximum 2 divisions per horse (1 division per day maximum)

Entry MUST include division #s and schooling round #s entered Changes only accepted; no additions allowed once entry is submitted. (there will be NO charges for Changes or Scratching from classes/divisions if done by the change deadlines)

VIRTUAL SHOW OFFICE: All changes / scratches MUST be done via email teesdaleshowoffice@gmail.com

Change Deadlines: Friday 8:00pm for Saturday, Saturday 5:00pm for Sunday.

Braiding is not required or recommended (hired braiders not allowed on property)

Riders are strongly recommended to bring their own Numbers (Jumper #'s are adequate for Hunters as well). Number available IF required (email show office)

There is no requirement to check in / out of horse show (all prize monies will be etransfered to recipient indicated on entry form)


