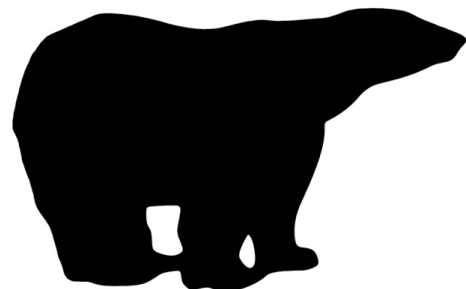

EC Silver Competition

The Teesdale August Tournament 2023 competition is sanctioned as a Silver competition of Equestrian Canada c/o House of Sport 2451 Riverside Drive, Ottawa, Ontario, K1H 7X7 and is governed by the rules of EC.” (A602.1)

EC STATEMENT OF PRINCIPLE

Equestrian Canada (EC), the national equestrian federation of Canada, supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all activities under its jurisdiction. EC is committed to:

- Upholding the welfare of the horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities.
- Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect, and the compassion that they deserve, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment.
- Ensuring that owners, trainers and exhibitors or their agents use responsible care in the handling, treatment, and transportation of their horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose.
- Providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure.
- Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare.
- Increasing education in training and horsemanship practices.
- Requiring owners, trainers, and exhibitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization’s rules, and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competition.
- Reviewing, revising, and developing competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of the horses.
- The standard by which conduct, or treatment will be measured is that which a person, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibition procedures, would determine to be neither cruel, abusive, nor inhumane.

Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules of EC and will be held and judged in accordance with the EC Rule Book.” (A602.2)

When registering for EC sanctioned competitions, athletes must indicate the name of their coach on the entry form or specify that they are self-coached. Coaches from other countries, must be in good standing with their home federation and must declare/have proof of insurance. See Rules of Equestrian Canada, Section A, General Regulations, Article 102, Safe Sport Environments.

Per Article A801, every entry at an EC-sanctioned competition shall constitute an agreement by the person responsible that the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver or rider and horse shall be subject to the EC constitution and all rules of EC and any additional rules set by the competition...” (A602.7)

Any horse entered in any class at a competition may be selected for equine medication control testing while at the event location.” (A602.5)

All horse entered in any class at a competition must have met the requirements of Article A519, Vaccinations. See Rules of Equestrian Canada, Section A, General Regulations, Article A519, Vaccinations.” (A602.8)

ENTRY FORM WAIVER

All owners and competitors and trainers are personally responsible for damages to this person caused by themselves, their employees, their agents, or their horses. The owners and competitors and trainers **MUST** have third party insurance to provide full coverage for participation in equestrian events at Teesdale English Riding School and to keep all policies current and fully updated. Neither AEF, Teesdale English Riding School and Boarding Stables Inc., Thompson Equestrian Partners, nor the organizing committee, board of directors, sponsors, employees, volunteers nor contractors shall be in any way liable for any accident, injury, death, damage, loss or any other matter that may happen, from any causes or circumstances whatsoever to competitors, exhibitors, horses, or members of their family or their agents, or to any one on Teesdale English Riding School premises, listed in this prize book or to any animal or article exhibited or to any property brought on to Teesdale English Riding School, or for any other loss, claim, matter, circumstance or event whatsoever in connection with or arising out of or attributable to any of the Teesdale English Riding School Tournament or any journey to and from the competition.
